





Want to be healthy and strong?

JOIN OUR CHOIR!

Research shows that singing in a choir has amazing health benefits, both physical and mental. Some health professionals are even prescribing choral singing as a treatment for medical conditions!

For a regulated heart rate!

Researchers discovered that choir members see their heart rates beat in unison in relation to the speed of their breathing. Their heart rates were directly affected by the melody of the music. Reducing the variability of your heart rate has a positive impact on your overall health.

To reduce stress levels and depression!

Several studies have proven many mental health benefits to singing. One study found that people who had actually been diagnosed with depression no longer met that diagnosis after their participation in a choir! Other studies have shown the impact that group singing has on boosting oxytocin levels, which help to control stress and anxiety.

Improve Parkinson's and lung disease symptoms!

A music professor established a choir specifically for people with Parkinson's Disease. Some participants shared how their voices had been strengthened, despite having the disease for more than five years! Researchers at Cardiff University found in 2012 that lung cancer patients who sang in a choir had greater expiratory capacity than those who did not.

Increased feelings of social wellbeing!

Stewart's study discovered that choral singers expressed a higher rate of social wellbeing than those who only sang solos. The social wellbeing rates for choral singers was very similar to those who participate in team sports.

Increased life expectancyll

I know this is a big claim, but a joint study by Harvard and Yale Universities in 2008 actually documented the result that a certain group of people who sang in a choir in Connecticut had longer life expectancies!

Best of all, eternal spiritual benefits!!

And for us, members of God's family, we know that there is no greater benefit than singing the praises of our Heavenly Father and Lord Jesus Christ! Benefits for now and for eternity in that heavenly choir!

So, surely after reading all that, you will not hesitate to come and join our choir!
