Our daughter is in Israel right now (pray) as part of a class trip from her university. Before she left, her class assignments required her to research some of the sites that they will be visiting and doing some archeological work. Why? So that she can really appreciate and understand what she is viewing and experiencing.

An author of an award-winning travel book commented that folks used to be "travelers" and have instead become "trippers." Where once tourists studied to understand what they would be seeing, now, having no background of understanding, they just look on amazing relics of the past and are unaware of their meaning and significance.

Your church staff wants you to not be a "tripper" in God's Word, but a "traveler" whose travels deeply impact your life. Let's take a cue from Deut. 31 where we have the record of Moses handing off the torch of leadership to Joshua.

Deut.31:12 says, *Gather the people – men, women, children, and foreigners living within your gates – so that they may listen and learn to fear the Lord your God and be careful to follow all the words of the law.* sound of voice (or within the reach of this mailing) to gather together regularly for several things pointed out in this verse:

Through the "Read The Bible for Life" study by Dr. George Guthrie, we were introduced to a series of methods, helping you to understand the different parts of the bible and how to read it in context in order to get the best interpretation. Now we want to encourage you to take what you have learned and continue the practice of reading God's Word everyday.

2018 Sunday Morning Bible Study Plan.

Now that we have looked a the methods it is time to put what we have learned in practice. In 2018 we will embark on a one year plan to read and study the entire Bible in a chronological (story form) plan. This vision to see all of our church read the entire Bible, in a story format, will produce greater understanding of God, His story, and how we relate to it.

All of our Sunday Morning Bible Study Groups, from youth through adults, will be participating in this plan that will help us fulfill part of the mission of making disciples. We encourage all participants to pick up a copy of the "Readers Guide To The Bible : Chronological Reading Plan" By Dr. George Guthrie. This book will serve as your Sunday Morning Bible Study curriculum for the entire year. Each day you will read the brief commentary provided in the book followed by the assigned reading in the bible for that day. Then on Sundays you will meet with your Sunday Morning Bible Study groups

Reading the Bible on a daily to discuss the readings for that you will wholeheartedly embrace this effort and not only make the commitment to participate for the entire year but to serve as an encourager to others as we progress through this plan. In addition to the book, which is provided for you through our Discipleship Ministry, there are several other tools that are available that you may want to consider to customize your reading and study.

Why Sing God's Praise?


The Bible has over 400 references to singing, and over 50 direct com- So, if you want to be more like mands to sing his praise. The longest book in the Bible, Psalms, is actually a song book. And in the New Testament we are commanded not just once but twice to sing psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs worship of the One who gave us to one another. (Ephesians 5:19 & this wonderful gift of singing! Colossians 3:16)

Why does God so often tell us to sing his praises? Why not just pray and preach? Why sing? There are many reasons, but one that I believe is of utmost importance is because our God himself sings! "The Lord your God is with you, he is mighty to save. He will take great delight in you, he will quiet you with his love, he will rejoice over you with sing-

ing." (Zephaniah 3:17) In Matthew 26:30 we learn that even on the very eve of his crucifixion, Jesus sang hymns with his disciples. And Ephesians 5 teaches us that one result of being filled with the Spirit is "addressing one another in psalms, and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody to the Lord in your heart." (Ephesians 5:18-19) Our

triune God is a singing God, and he wants us to be like him!

Christ, singing his praises is an important part of your spiritual growth. It doesn't have to be beautiful by man's standards, it just has to be sincere, heart-felt
