Let's Talk About Re-opening FBCA!

Throughout history God's "called out ones" -- His church -- has taken the lead in society, giving wise counsel, direction, and issuing a call to be a people of courage and faith in our great God. So as our society begins to re-open, how can FBCA lead out, demonstrating both wisdom and trust in the Lord?

After prayerful study and discussion, our intent is to **re-open** on **Sunday, May 17th** -- in modified form. We will be re-opening, <u>not</u> with any Sunday Bible study classes, but with <u>2 worship services</u>:

9:15AM -- 10AM & 10:30AM -- 11:15AM.

TIME CONSIDERATIONS:

The **9:15AM worship time** is especially **open** to our **65+ members**.

That service will **conclude** promptly at **10AM** and you will be asked to vacate the building. Please enter and exit close to where you park. **East entrances** (children's) will **not** be used.

There will be a quick cleaning of our facility to prepare for the 10:30AM service.

If you will be attending the 10:30AM service, please arrive around 10:15AM.

The doors for the 10:30AM service will open by 10:20AM.

You will be asked to vacate the building after 11:15AM.

BEHAVIOR CONSIDERATIONS:

The worship area has been reconfigured with rows spaced at 6ft and aisles at 8ft.

You are encouraged to sit by family units and are asked to maintain "personal space."

Hand sanitizers and tissue will be made available for use.

Use of **masks** and / or **gloves** are certainly **welcomed**, but **not required**. (Bring your own).

Restrooms are **available** off the foyer and by the choir room on an **emergency** basis.

We will not be having a "meet-and-greet" time.

Tithes & offerings will be received at the worship area **exit doors** at the conclusion.

You are welcome to socially visit in the parking areas using appropriate "personal space."

OTHER CONSIDERATIONS:

Live-stream worship will continue on *Facebook* and at <u>fbcalvarado.org</u> for those who are of higher risk or those who are not yet ready to join with us for public worship.

<u>Please do not attend</u> if you've had any COVID-19 symptoms or feel that you've been exposed. If you <u>do</u> attend and later <u>develop symptoms</u> or <u>test positive</u> for the virus please <u>notify</u> the church office or a staff member <u>immediately!</u>

We will not be holding any in-person <u>Bible study classes</u> at this time. There are just too many spatial issues to consider this a safe practice for now.
