Many trace the Christmas Candle tradition to Martin Luther (16th century) who added lit candles to his tree, explaining, "The candles remind us of the star that led wise men to the Christ child."

In the Middle Ages, a large candle was used to represent the star of Bethlehem.

We use advent candles at our churches, pointing to the coming of the Messiah, Jesus.

Jesus said, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows Me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life." (Jn.8:12)

He also told us, His disciples, "You are the light of the world. ...let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven." (Mt.5:14,16)

So quickly this crazy year has passed -- 2020, which begin so full of hope, and quickly took a sharp curve into fear. One writer reminded me recently that the church has historically been a place of refuge and moral authority -- a shining candle of hope in a dark world.

Today, our world, country, state, county, and community needs the church to once again be the shining candle of hope -- hope in Jesus. Hey believer, let's not live in fear -- nothing, not even a virus, should imprison our mind and heart and keep us from following God and His will for our life. Instead of living in fear, let's walk in faith and cling to the hope that we have -- ... Christ in you, the hope of glory. (Col.1:27)

My prayer for you and your family this season is an echo of his prayer for them: May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing so that by the power of the Holy Spirit you may abound in hope. (Rom.15:13)
