Among the negative voices and fear-mongering rhetoric that assault us on a daily basis from our press and social media, this pastor continues to desire to be a voice of reason and hope. I'm convicted of the need for more voices "crying in the wilderness to prepare the way for the Lord." (Is.40:3) Instead of hiding under our covers, we need to be shouting a battle cry against our enemies. (1Sam.17:47) The real battle we face is not with a virus -- it's with 2 other enemies -- our own mortality and a monster named fear.

Is Covid-19 real? Yes it is. Is it a threat to our physical health? Sure it is! No one wants to be sick. Does contracting it mean we will die? No! Almost 3 dozen of our church members have contracted Covid-19 over the last 9 months -- none of them have died. No more than a couple of them have reached serious condition, but have recovered. Most have had a mild case.

Isn't it dangerous to attend church these days? Of those nearly 3 dozen sick folks, NONE seem to have contracted the virus while at church. That means attending church is one of the "safest" places you can be!! We have plenty of personal space for all of us, both in our Bible studies classes and also in corporate worship. A recent Gallop poll found that only one group of people saw a positive change in how they rated their mental health during this year of pandemic — those who attended religious services weekly. Unless you are a high risk individual, reconsider attending with us. If you are a high risk individual, participate with us on livestream.

Some have been facing their own mortality for the first time in their life and it scares them to death! (Pun intended) There are no guarantees in this life -- it is full of daily risks. We have to make sure we're ready for the next life -- the life that begins when we trust Jesus as Savior & Lord and lasts for eternity with Him. If you aren't ready, you need to be scared!! If you are ready, there is no reason for fear.

A guy well acquainted with life's uncertainties (David) penned Ps.27:1 -- *The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The Lord is the stronghold of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?*

Prov.29:25 says, *The fear of man lays a snare; but whoever trusts in the Lord is safe.*

Paul reminded his mentee Timothy that *God gave us a spirit not of fear but of power and love and self-control.* (2Tim.1:6) Then he wrote, *..for I know whom I have believed, and am convinced that He is able to guard until that Day what has been entrusted to me.* (2Tim.1:12)

At some point our physical life on this earth will end -- but we have a home waiting for us if we know Jesus! Until that time comes, we can walk in "no-fear" and in simple trust of the One who has made us and sustains us. (Acts 17:28)
