

Have you heard about the "Great Reset?" Many world leaders are calling on us to buy into a reform movement that replaces democracies with socialism and capitalism with a global financial system. Climate change is a large selling point and their official slogan is (ironically) also being used by our current administration -- "Build Back Better." But I want to propose another course of direction for the church -- a "Great Rebuild."

In the OT, God's people had been in exile for 70 years and were being allowed to move back to Jerusalem and rebuild, especially the Temple and the city walls. Emerging from spiritual exile their cry was, "Let us arise and build." (Neh.2:18)

Emerging from Covid-19's dark days, God's leaders (like me) are praying for God's wisdom in moving forward in face-to-face relationships and ministry. There is no instruction manual for the months of challenge behind us / before us -- or is there?! Maybe we've been looking to science, politics, or public opinion as our guides for too long! Maybe our better guide is God's Word -- that Word that seems to shout at us, "Arise and rebuild!" Our spiritual house is in disrepair -- we need a fresh work of God!

The church of Jesus today faces similar challenges as Zerubbabel, Ezra, and Nehemiah faced in their day. Forget 20/20 vision -- what kind of vision do we have for 2025 or 2030? Will we remain comfortable and complacent -- at home in our PJ's or walking through our days in mere survival mode? Or will we get together with our brothers and sisters in Jesus and cry out, "Arise and rebuild!" Will you ask God to increase your burden for the lost and hurting in our community and beyond? Will you ask God to give you His vision for your life, ministry, and service once again? Church, let's say it together -- and mean it from our hearts -- "LET US ARISE & RE-BUILD!"
