

We will go all out in order to get something we really want. Some will spend hours in the gym so they can make the team. Some will count calories to get into that new dress. Some will camp out all night to get that newly released phone or much sought-after tickets. As long as we personally benefit from our effort, we'll do whatever it takes to make it happen. What about if someone else stands to benefit from our effort -- will we put out the same amount of effort?

Matthew, Mark, and Luke all tell us about a paralyzed man who was healed by Jesus, probably at Peter's house. There was a real crowd there that day, but this man who could not walk had some real friends -- Lk.5:18 calls them *some men* and Mrk.2:3 just says *they*. What is important is not who they were but what they did! Lk.5:18 says that *they were seeking to bring him in and lay him before Jesus*. Being blocked by the door committee and the window committee they moved on to the roof committee and dug through the mortar / tar / ash / grass mixture in order to lower the man's mat (with him on it!) down into the house. These friends have a persistent, urgent faith, risking disruption, misunderstanding, and probably ridicule just to get their friend to Jesus!

What are we willing to put out in order for folks to encounter Jesus? Some of the folks that you know may never encounter Him unless you lift a corner of their stretcher and bring them to Jesus. You may be the one who plants or waters or cultivates the seed of faith in their life -- or even the one who gets to harvest it! How much effort are you willing to put forth?
