- *We pray for FBCA's outreach and growth -- we can also prayer-walk a neighborhood, invite friends and neighbors to attend, and gain a hearing with them by serving a need in their life.

There are all kinds of ways to put feet to our faith. James encourages us in that, like James 2:18 says, ...I will show you my faith by my works. FBCA family, let's say amen with a hoe!
