As we journey through the gospel of John each Sunday, we come this month to the 2nd of Jesus' "7 Signs" -- miracles that help us know who Jesus is and believe in Him as the Son of God.

Jn.4:46-54 is all about the healing of the royal official's son. It's a great story! What makes it great is that it really happened!

What makes it even better is what vs.53 tells us about the father and his family -- *And he himself believed, and all his household.* This dad believed so completely that as a result of God's work and his witness, his whole household believed also. Several times in Scripture we are told a similar thing.

Acts 16 tells us that the Philippian jailer of Paul & Silas *believed in God with all his household.*

Acts 10 & 11 tells us that God sent Peter to a Roman centurion named Cornelius so that he and all his *household will be saved.* (Act 11:14)

And Acts 18:8 gives us big news! It says that at Corinth, *Crispus, the ruler of the synagogue, believed in the Lord together with his entire household.*

Allow me to make a point and an application. Not only did the *household* include blood relatives, it also included extended family and their family servants.

What could God do in the Alvarado community if we could find a way to reach, not just individuals (especially dads), but whole families -- *households*?

Be looking as we move towards April for a real way to "BLESS EVERY HOME."

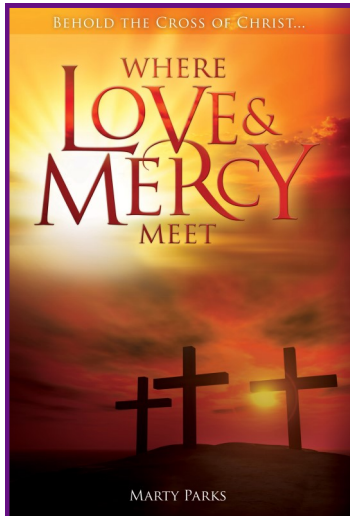

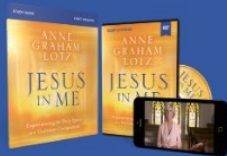
