David often reminded his hearers to find purpose in waiting on the Lord.

Wait for the Lord; be strong and let your heart take courage; wait for the Lord. (Ps.27:14)

For God alone, O my soul, wait in silence, for my hope is from Him. (Ps.62:5)

Wait for the Lord and keep His way, and He will exalt you to inherit the land... (Ps.37:34)

Some of us today may be in a "waiting mode" about a job, a financial situation, a grandbaby's arrival, results of a medical test, or (perish the thought!) school to begin!

Some of our FBCA family may be impatient about our future or about filling our staff position needs.

Times of waiting that test our patience can be so beneficial to us!


James 1:2-3 -- My brethren, count it all joy when you fall into various trials, knowing that the testing of your faith produces patience. (NKJV)
