

October is the 10th month on our official "Gregorian" calendar. But, wait a minute! Doesn't "octa" or "octo" mean "eight?" You know, like "octopus" or "octagon?" Apparently, the old Roman calendar started with March so October was the 8th month. But when the Roman senate adopted the Gregorian calendar in 153BC, January and February where added and October became the 10th month.

Things can drastically change if there are additions to it. That paint color with an additional pigment...that recipe with an additional ingredient...the family dynamic when that 1st baby comes along -- those additions can bring a drastic change to the original.

The same is true of Scripture. John tells us in Jn.21:25 that *many other things that Jesus did* were not written down and even that the world itself could not contain *the books that would be written* about Him and the things that He did and is doing. However, we do have a complete collection of God's revelation to us in His Scripture.

John also warns us in His last letter, the book of Revelation, that it is a serious thing if *anyone adds to them* or *takes away from the words of the book* (Rev.21: 18-19).

Let's never add to God's Word but always allow God's Word to speak for itself -- to allow God to speak for Himself. This world system is busy trying to lure believers to lose their distinctiveness and earnestly trying to dilute and weaken our foundation, God's Word. Let's continually act on Jude's advice in Jude 3, ... to contend for the faith that was once for all delivered to the saints. His practical advice? But you, beloved, building yourselves up in your most holy faith, and praying in the Holy Spirit, keep yourselves in the love of God, waiting for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ that leads to eternal life (Jude 20-21).

So, let's put our faith into practice, pray, pass along God's love, and help others come to know the eternal life that He has given us. Doesn't that sound like a good October plan?! Maybe it also sounds like a good plan for the rest of the months too!
